

**RE: MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2013-09-001, Series 2013 "AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING THE DISPOSITION AND ALLOCATION OF THE PER FAMILY PAYMENT RATE (PFPR) OF THE PHIL. HEALTH INSURANCE CORPORATION FOR HEALTH CARE FACILITIES OF THE MUNICIPALITY, RENDERING OUTPATIENT CARE FOR SPONSORED MEMBERS, ORGANIZED GROUPS AND OVERSEES FILIPINO WORKERS INCLUDING THEIR QUALIFIED DEPENDENTS.**

**FINDINGS AND OBSERVATIONS:**

1. Municipal Ordinance No. 2013 – 596, Series 2013 of the Municipality of Dingras, Ilocos Norte finds jurisdiction in the following provisions of:

A. Republic Act 7160 – Local Government Code 1991

Section 16, General Welfare. – Every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental of its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety, enhance the right of the people to a balanced ecology, encourage and support the development of appropriate and self reliant scientific and technological capabilities, improve public morals, enhance economic prosperity and social justice promote full employment among their residents, maintain peace and order, and preserve comfort and convenience of the inhabitants.

B. Republic Act 7885 as amended by Republic Act No. 9241- " An Act Instituting a National Health Insurance Program (NHIP) and Establishing the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PHILHEALTH)."

Section 1 (b) requires PHILHEALTH to provide out patient care services to its members that include (i) services of health care professionals (ii) diagnostic, laboratory and other medical examination services and (iii) personal preventive services.

The said Municipal Ordinance is in compliance and in conformity with the provisions of PHILHEALTH Board Resolution No. 1587, s 2012, amending the implementation of the Out Patient Benefit Package and PHILHEALTH Circular No. 010. S 2012 – Implementing Guidelines for Universal Health Care Primary Care Benefit I (PCB I) Package.

**AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING THE DISPOSITION AND ALLOCATION OF THE PER FAMILY PAYMENT RATE (PFPR) OF THE PHIL. HEALTH INSURANCE CORPORATION FOR HEALTH CARE FACILITIES OF THE MUNICIPALITY, RENDERING OUTPATIENT CARE FOR SPONSORED MEMBERS, ORGANIZED GROUPS AND OVERSEAS FILIPINO WORKERS INCLUDING THEIR QUALIFIED DEPENDENTS**

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**BE IT ORDAINED THAT:**

Section 1 – Pursuant to PhilHealth Memorandum Circular No. 10, series 2012, the Per Family Payment Rate (PFPR) under the Primary Care Benefit Package shall be disposed and allocated as follows:

- A. Eighty percent (80%) of PFPR is for operational cost and shall cover:
  - a. Minimum of forty percent (40%) for drugs and medicines listed in the Philippine National Drug Formulary (PNDF) to be dispensed at the facility including drugs and medicines for asthma, acute gastroenteritis and pneumonia;
  - b. Maximum of forty percent (40%) for reagents, medical supplies, equipments (i.e. ambulance, ambubag, stretcher, etc.) information technology (IT equipment specific to the needs of facility for it to facilitate reporting and building up for its database) capacity building for staff, infrastructure or any other use related, necessary for the delivery of required service including referral fees for diagnostic services if not available in the facility
  
- B. The remaining twenty percent (20%) shall be exclusively utilized as honoraria of the staff of the health facility and in the improvement of their
