**MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2014-09-013
Series of 2014**

**AN ORDINANCE ENACTING THE EDUCATION FOR ENVIRONMENTAL VALUES
AND SOCIAL AWARENESS FOR GREEN GOVERNANCE BY PROVIDING UNIFORM
INCENTIVES FOR DEVELOPMENT PERTAINING TO KALIKASAN (EEV and SAGUID
KALIKASAN) PROGRAM**


WHEREAS, under Section 16 of the Local Government Code, a local government unit has the primary obligation to promote health and safety; and enhance the right of the people to a balanced ecology;

WHEREAS, one of the program thrusts and policies of the Municipal Government of Dingras, Ilocos Norte is to establish a clean and healthy environment;


WHEREAS, the Municipal Government of Dingras, Ilocos Norte tends to promote programs and activities that will foster unified efforts for environmental cleanliness;

WHEREAS, the establishment and organization of a clean and green contest will encourage the different barangays in the municipality to actively participate in the pursuit of a clean and green environment.

WHEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Joey S. Apostol duly seconded by Hon. Ruben C. Marcos, **BE IT ORADINED THAT**

Section 1. This ordinance shall be known and called as Education for Environmental Values and Social Awareness for Green Governance by providing Uniform Incentives for Development pertaining to "KALIKASAN" or "EEV and Saguid Kalikasan."


Section 2. When used in this ordinance:



1. Municipality - refers to the Municipality of Dingras, Ilocos Norte.
2. Barangays- refers to all the thirty one (31) barangays in the Municipality of Dingras Ilocos Norte.
3. Biodegradable- refers to organic wastes (e.g. kitchen wastes, vegetables, fruits, flowers, leaves, papers, etc.)
4. Non-biodegradable- refers to inorganic wastes (e.g. plastics, papers, glass, metals, etc.)

Section 3. There shall be an Annual Clean and Green Contest for the different barangays in the Municipality.

Section 2. The criteria for the Annual Clean and Green Contest shall be the following, to wit:

- a. Thirty Percent (30%) for proper garbage segregation and disposal. Waste shall be segregated on basis of biodegradable and non-biodegradable wastes;
- b. Thirty Percent (30%) for tree planting activities; and
- c. Forty Percent (40%) for beautification and cleanliness.

Section 3. There is hereby created the Clean and Green Committee that shall implement and monitor the Clean and Green Contest and shall determine the winning barangays for the Annual Clean and Green Contest

The Clean and Green Committee shall be composed of the following, to wit:



Section 4. The Clean and Green Committee shall also adopt other measures, rules and regulations that are necessary and reasonable in the implementation of the contest.

Section 5. The incentives or prizes for the winning barangays shall be the following, to wit:

- a. First Prize - Fifty Thousand Pesos (Php. 50,000.00) and Plaque
- b. Second Prize - Thirty Thousand Pesos (Php. 30,000.00) and Plaque
- c. Third Prize - Ten Thousand Pesos (Php. 10,000.00) and Plaque
- d. Five Consolation Prizes - Five Thousand (Php. 5,000.00) Each
- e. Participation Incentive – Two Thousand Pesos (Php.2,000.00) / participant barangay

Section 6. The amount of Two Hundred Thousand Pesos (Php 200,000.00) shall be allocated annually, either from the annual or supplemental budget, in order to successfully carry out the Clean and Green Contest.

Section 7. The contest shall start every month of April until February of the following year. The announcement of winners and giving of prizes shall be during the Ani Festival in the month of March.



Section 8. This ordinance shall take effect upon its compliance with the requirements of the law on posting, publication and public hearing.


