A RESOLUTION TO RESPECTFULLY AND EARNESTLY REQUESTING HIS EXCELLENCY BENIGNO SIMEON AQUINO III, PRESIDENT, REPUBLIC OF THE PHILIPPINES, TO DECLARE SEPTEMBER 11, 2014 AS A SPECIAL (NON WORKING) HOLIDAY IN THE PROVINCE OF ILOCOS NORTE, IN HONOR OF THE LATE FERDINAND E. MARCOS, SR., AN OUTSTANDING AND RENOWNED LEADER.

WHEREAS, the late Ferdinand E. Marcos was born on September 11, 1917 in Sarrat, Ilocos Norte.

WHEREAS, he emerged as Bar Topnotcher during the 1939 Bar Examinations;

WHEREAS, Ferdinand E. Marcos, Sr. became a Senator after he served as member of the House of Representatives for three terms, then later as Minority Floor Leader before gaining the Senate Presidency. He was elected as President of the Republic of the Philippines in the year 1965 and was re-elected in 1969;

WHEREAS, as a leader, he had introduced significant policies, programs, and projects for the country's development and the empowerment of people;

WHEREAS, indeed, Ferdinand E. Marcos, Sr., is an outstanding person, leader, and an inspiration to the people, especially to the Ilocanos;


